CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. No responsibility will be accepted by the organisers for any loss, damage, injury or illness sustained by the exhibitors, riders or their horses or ponies and all entries are accepted on this basis.
2. **The organizers reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate any classes if there are insufficient entries or to amend the conditions of any class at their discretion.**
3. Entries will not be acknowledged unless a stamped addressed envelope is submitted with the entry.
4. No numbers will be sent to exhibitors before the show date. Competitors' numbers to be collected from the secretary's office on showground.
5. Membership and Registration will be suspended immediately, if cheques payable to the BSPS., the BSPS Championships Show or a BSPS Area are not honoured by the bank or if there is any money owing to the BSPS, the Championships Show or a BSPS Area or A BSPS Affiliated show or if ANY TROPHIES belonging to the BSPS, the BSPS Championships Show or a BSPS Area are not returned by the requested date. A surcharge of £10 will be charged if cheques have to be represented.
6. The judges listed in the schedule have accepted our invitation to judge but the committee reserve the right to appoint substitutes should any of the appointed judges withdraw or classes over run.
7. THE TIMETABLE IS PROVISIONAL AND THE COMMITTEE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO AMEND AT THEIR DISCRETION. Every effort is made to avoid clashing of classes, but IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE COMPETITOR TO ENSURE THEY CAN COMPETE IN THE CLASSES ENTERED. THE COMMITTEE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO CANCEL THE SHOW
8. Committee decisions will be final.

10. All trophy winners must sign for their trophies and return them to the secretary promptly and in good repair when requested.

11. All competitors and visitors to the show MUST adhere to the requests of the car parking attendants or you will be requested to leave the showground.

12. Rosettes to 4th place all classes. All prize money MUST be collected on the day of the show, otherwise it will be forfeited. Entries will not be accepted without the appropriate fee. If 6 or less competitors in any class, then only 1st prize money will be awarded.

SOCIETIES RULES & CONDITIONS

BSPS RULES

This show is affiliated to the BSPS, and all classes are held in accordance with the 2024 Rule & Show Handbook and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the Constitution and Rules of the BSPS including the disciplinary procedures and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS. Please take note of Rule 63 (1a) regarding DOPE Testing in the 2024 BSPS Rule book Owners and riders must be BSPS members to compete in classes with qualification for BLUE RIBAND, RIHS (including Pretty Polly & Heritage classes) and animals must be registered with the BSPS, except for Anglo & PB Arabs who must be reg. with AHS.

QUALIFICATIONS

This show is a qualifier for the **Royal International Horse Show**. Only one pony in each of the Open Ridden Show Pony Classes (97-99) Lead Rein Show Pony (68) First Ridden Show Pony (69) Lead Rein Hunter Type (70) Open Show Hunter Classes (22-25), Heritage Open Lead Rein and Heritage Open First Ridden (58-59), Intermediate classes (100-102) Pretty Polly Mixed Height Show Pony (13), Pretty Polly Heritage Lead Rein (52) Pretty Polly Heritage First Ridden (53), Pretty Polly Show Hunter Pony (13), Pretty Polly Heritage Mixed Breeds (46), Pretty Polly SRT & SH (14) and Ridden Arab/Part Bred (71, 72), Open Heritage Ridden (47-51) Nursery Stakes (11) Open WHP including Int.(7-10) qualifies being the highest (not already qualified) from the first three ponies. RIHS qualification is subject to confirmation from BSPS Head Office. This show is a qualifier for the **BSPS Summer Championships Simply the Best** to be held at the Arena UK, Grantham. 1st & 2nd Prize winners will qualify in classes 64-65, 69-70, 7-9, 11, 15-17, 97-99, 34, 22-25 & 18-21. 1st 2nd & 3rd prize winners in classes 33,10, 82-84, 100-102, 1st -4th in Class 6 provided the animal is owned, registered, and ridden by a BSPS member or in accordance with the BSPS rules 21 & 26. This show is a qualifier for the **BSPS Blue Riband Pony of the Year**, the 1st and 2nd prize winners in the, Open SP Classes (97-99) Open SHP Classes (22-25), Open Lead Rein & First Ridden (68-69), Open SRT & SH (100-102) Open WHP (7-9) Int WHP (10)

BSPS BLACK COUNTRY SADDLES BEST RIDER

The winner of the BSPS Area 2B Best Rider Championship will go forward to represent BSPS Area 2B in the BSPS Black Country Saddles Best Rider Championship to be held at the BSPS Summer Championship show to be held at Arena UK Grantham.

THE BSPS CHALLENGE 2024

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Challenge. Animals must have qualified for the Challenge by attending any BSPS affiliated show and competed in the appropriate class. Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Lead Rein Of Hunter Type, Open Show Pony, SHP, Open Cradle & Nursery Stakes, WHP, Int. SRT, SH & WH & Heritage Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden & WHP classes. Ponies must not have qualified for the HOYS 2024. If a pony qualifies for the HOYS 2024 it will forfeit its qualification for the BSPS Challenge.

THE BSPS BINKS FAMILY CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS

At all BSPS affiliated shows the 1st prize-winners in the following classes will qualify for the Binks Family Champion of Champions; - Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Show Pony, Open WHP, Open SHP, Open LRHT, Open Intermediate SH, SRT & WH and Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden & WHP classes.

THE BSPS BINKS FAMILY MINI WHP CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS

At all BSPS affiliated shows the 1st Prize Winners in the Open Cradle & Nursery Stakes will qualify for the The Binks Family Mini WHP Champion of Champions.

CHAPS UK AFF NO: 24-056

This show is affiliated to The Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK) affiliation number 24-056. Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse of pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete. However, in order to qualify both owner and rider/exhibitor need to be current showing member and present their valid qualifier Card. Members to apply in writing to CHAPS (UK) for the appropriate qualifier card. The CHAPS (UK) Championship show will be held in August 2024. Classes 85-90 are CHAPS (UK) qualifiers. For full rulings and information on competition/qualification please refer to the CHAPS (UK) Members handbook or www.chapsuk.com for rulings. Skewbald's & Piebald's may compete in these classes. All Stallions 4 years old and over must be graded with CHAPS UK to compete and must wear Stallion CHAPS ID discs in the ring without exception.

BSPA RIHS QUALIFIERS 2024

Classes 92-95 are affiliated to the British Skewbald & Piebald Association and are qualifiers for the RIHS, Hickstead on Tuesday 23rd July 2024. Classes will be judged under BSPA rules. Download from www.bsponline.com. All horses/ponies must be registered and all owners and riders BSPA members prior to the show. Rider age taken from 1st January. Membership cards must be carried in the ring by competitors and produced as required for inspection or signature. Failure to do so will mean disqualification. Spurs may not be worn in any pony class. Ponies 153cms and under (Shetlands exempt) must possess a current JMB height certificate. All stallions must be graded and licensed by BSPA or hold a BSPA Showing permit (contact BSPA for Stallion showing permit information) and have a BSPA stallion ID card and wear BSPA Stallion ID Disc. No rider under 14 may exhibit a stallion in any class. Qualification: 1st place and the next unqualified competitor standing 2nd or 3rd qualify from each class. No competitor may qualify from lower than 3rd place. BSPA office 01354 638226 bspashows@gmail.com. Skewbald and Piebald horse/ponies only. Highest placed

amateur and the highest placed junior in each class qualify for Amateur and Junior Supreme Championship finals to be held at BSPA World of Colour Championship Show. Cards to be shown and qualification card signed. Competitors qualifying at this show for the RIHS 23-28 July 2024 must submit their entries online at <https://www.hickstead.co.uk/entries-results-schooling/the-royal-international-horse-show/> . Schedules will be available to download in April. Online entries will open on 1st May and entries will close on 3rd June 2024.

UK PONIES & HORSES LTD AFF NO 24/A18/8341

This Show is affiliated to UK Ponies & Horses and classes 103-106 are qualifiers for the RIHS Young Riders & Amateur classes. For these classes, owners must be Adult/life members & riders must be current UK Ponies & Horses Annual Members and the Ponies currently registered with UK Ponies & Horses **before time of entry in order to compete in these classes**. The highest placed pony in each RIHS class in the top 5 that has not already qualified will qualify. Qualification will be verified by the Office. Please note the UK Ponies & Horses Amateur Rules, please see page 6-7 of the current UK Ponies & Horses Rule Book. Classes that are UK Ponies & Horses qualifiers as indicated in the schedule the 1st, 2nd & 3rd placed competitors will qualify for the Gold Series at UK Ponies & Horses Spring Classic 2025. No membership is required to enter or compete in any Championship Final. Only the 1st & 2nd prize-winners in the UK Ponies & Horses Small Breeds, Large Breeds & Intermediates will be eligible for the overall section championship. The 1st & 2nd prize-winners from the Amateur class will not be eligible but at this show will be eligible for the overall supreme of Show.

NPS MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND QUALIFYING ROUNDS AFF NO S5.086

NPS Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in any of the British Riding Pony studbook sections or the Ridden Register; the GSB; the AHSB; the AASB or registered in the main body of their respective M&M Stud Book. Part bred are not eligible unless over stamped into one of the British Riding Pony studbook sections. Or the Ridden Register. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern in August 2024. The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified. SPORT HORSE BREEDING (GB) RIHS WORKING HUNTER QUALIFIER

It is mandatory for competitors under the age of 18 to wear skull caps or hats.

Day tickets = £42 (this entitles competitors to compete at a maximum of 2 shows in the year at £42 per show – it covers owner and rider membership together with horse registration for that show). If the class is a RIHS qualifier, in order for the qualification to be valid, application for full owner/rider membership and horse registration must be received by SHB GB within 14 days. Owner & Rider must be current members. Any exhibit found not to be correctly registered will be disqualified. No Horse may be entered in a Ridden Hunter or Riding Horse class at the same show.
